Principal Engineer, Energy Efficiency; Brisbane City Council

Peter will discuss the formation of Council's Climate Change Taskforce and Council's target of buildings being 100 percent powered by renewable energy by July 2010. Peter will also discuss Council's policy for large-scale renewable developments, support for small to medium-sized demonstration projects (such as distributed energy) and why co-generation in commercial building is only an option if it powered by renewable energy. Over 1000 new residents move to Brisbane each week and Brisbane City Council is the largest local government in the Asia-Pacific Region, with the population of South East Queensland set to double in the next 40 years. Come and hear how Council is planning for a sustainable Brisbane.
